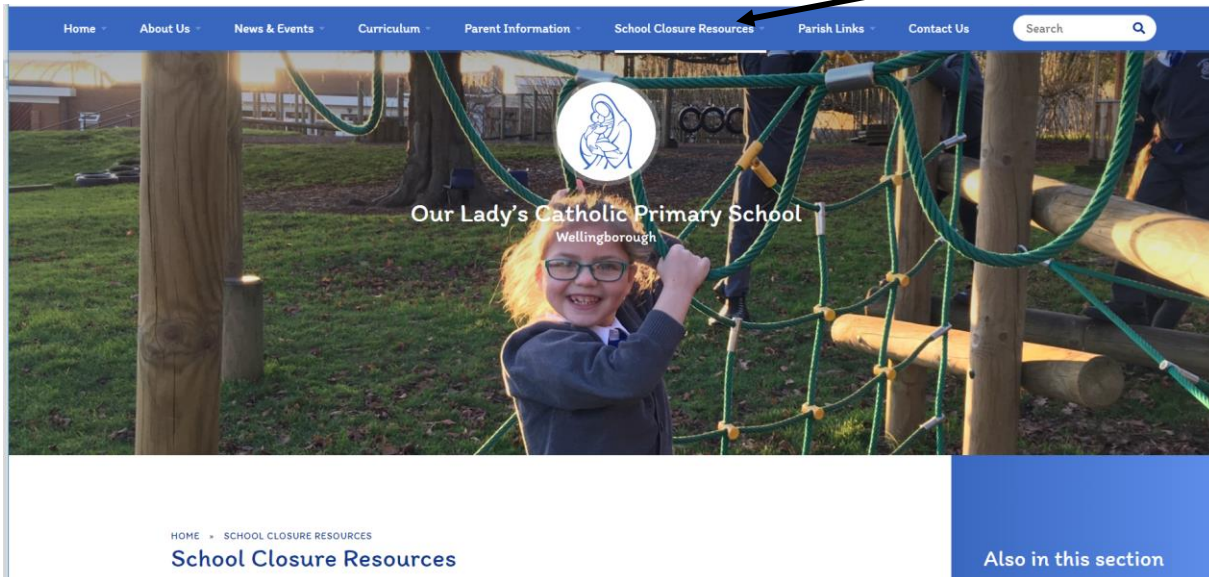
## Home Learning
