


A new exciting Outdoor Gym!

<u>Lateness</u>

Lateness is becoming a concern and there appears to be a group of children who are regularly late. We are looking at options to improve this with the support of the County Council.

Minutes late per day	Learning time lost in a year
5 minutes	3½ days
10 minutes	7 days
15 minutes	10 ½ days
20 minutes	14 days
30 minutes	21 days

Since September, we have had 926 Late marks with an average recently of 11 children each day.
