We Need Your Voice - Children and Young People's Mental Health and Primary Care Integration

Are you a parent, carer or a supporter of a young person who has accessed the GP or mental health services?

We are looking for parents, carers, and supporters to help design a new and efficient way for children and young people that ask for mental health advice, guidance and help to ensure that they get the resources they need and when they need it.

Some young people and carers described their experience of trying to access emotional support or mental health services. It took too long to see the GP. Sometimes the GP didn't know what was available. Sometimes the GP did referrals but didn't give any MH first aid. We explored what an additional model might be that meets the needs of children, young people and families asking for emotional wellbeing or mental health support at the right time, in the right place and with the right information.

What would something different look like? A fast-track service that can give us some helpful advice, techniques and if needed refer to the right services. Same day if possible. A nurse or other professional with the right knowledge. More than 10 minutes maybe 30 minutes. Same service to check on me/my child after they have been discharged.

Where would help be? It's less about the environment and more about accessibility. Either in person, phone, or video call. A brochure that explains what help is available. This could be a set of slides or videos that explains services or resources. At the doctors or remotely.

This event is an opportunity for people living with autism, professionals and those interested in better understanding the condition, to come together. This year we welcome Matthew Hardie as our keynote speaker, with "Defying the odds with Autism".

After being diagnosed with Asperger's Syndrome at the age of four, Matthew was predicted to have little chance of succeeding academically. Having overcome a lot of obstacles in his life, Matthew would like to share his story on how he lived with Autism.

Terry Arnold, known as "the expert always called on for help", was Northamptonshire's leading educational psychologist for autism in the late 1980s through to the year 2000. This was a time when the need for a service for autistic people was first being identified and, together with his wife Eileen, Terry nurtured links with the University of North Carolina, world leaders in the field of autism.

Terry led on the development of 'co-ordinating services' for autism and introduced new programmes which continue to benefit the people of Northamptonshire today.

Are you thinking of using reusable nappies when your baby is born. We now offer a free nappy loan service available for you. You can borrow a sample pack of reusable nappies for 6 weeks. Each pack contains 18 new-born nappies from 3 different manufacturers, a roll of liners and a washable storage bag.

The nappies are newborn size suitable for a baby 5-13lbs in weight.

The nappies will arrive at the library of your choice within 10 working days and the library will contact you when they are ready to collect. Alternatively, you can book on to your nearest Strong Start bumps and babies group and collect them there.
