

SOLIHULL APPROACH

Ask yourself:

Are you struggling to understand your child's behaviour? Do you need support in how to manage your children's emotions?

Is your relationship with your child becoming a battle?

THE SOLIHULL PROGRAMME COULD BE FOR YOU, IT IS FOR PARENTS & CARERS WITH CHILDREN 0-11 YEARS WHO WANT TO KNOW MORE ABOUT SENSITIVE AND EFFECTIVE PARENTING

The Solihull Approach 10 week course aims to:-

- Promote understanding of children's behaviour
- Tune into children
- Explore feelings & emotions
- Give you as parents/carers a strategy for repair when things go wrong
- Develop a framework for thinking about parent/child relationships, which can be developed into a lifelong skill
- Promote reflective, sensitive and effective parenting



IS THIS YOUR FAMILY?

- Your child constantly misbehaves
- Other families don't seem to have it as tough as you
- Your family life is full of anger and tears
- There's probably a lot of shouting
- From breakfast to bedtime, it's a battle

IF THIS SOUNDS LIKE YOUR FAMILY, TRIPLE P IS A POSITIVE PARENTING PROGRAMME OVER A PERIOD OF 8 WEEKS FOR PARENTS & CARERS OF CHILDREN FOR ALL AGE GROUPS

TRIPLE P STEPPING STONES GROUP FOR PARENTS/CARERS WHOSE CHILDREN HAVE ADDITIONAL NEEDS

This group is for six weeks, learning new skills, followed by three individual telephone consultations to help parents refine problem solving skills, helping prevent the development of problem behaviour.

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0 - 12 YEARS which can help you to:

- Encourage behaviour you like
- Deal with problem behaviour
- Become confident as a parent
- Be realistic about parenting
- Take care of yourself

TEENS AGED 11 UPWARDS which can help you to:

- Build a strong relationship with your child
 - Encourage positive behaviour
 - Resolve conflict
- Manage problem behaviour
- Help your child stay safe



Family Transitions Triple P

Is this you?

You're divorced or separated. Your child is caught in the middle. You may have problems with your extended family, your new partner or your ex. Holidays and birthdays cause arguments. You may be concerned about your finances, and you're worried about the impact this is all having on your child's behaviour and emotions. If this sounds familiar, Family Transitions Triple P can help.

What Is Family Transitions Triple P?

Family Transitions is a group parenting programme for divorced or separated parents. It gives you new ways to help protect your child – and yourself – from the fallout from a family split.

What happens at Family Transitions?

At Family Transitions sessions, you meet other parents going through many of the problems that come with divorce or separation. You will get new ideas, techniques and strategies to help you through the day-to-day dramas and ongoing trauma of your situation. These ideas can help you cope with stress, anger and change, resolve conflict, and communicate better with your ex.



Family Transitions Triple P

How long does it take?

There are five weekly sessions of two hours each. After the five sessions, you are welcome to join other parenting groups offered by Children and Family Support Services.

Does my ex-partner need to attend with me?

No. Family Transitions is not a mediation programme so you should attend on your own or, if you want support, with your new partner. If your expartner wants to do Family Transitions, you should attend separate groups. How do I join a parenting group
