As a parent/carer I will:

- Ensure that my child arrives at school on time, in full school uniform which is clearly labelled.
- Endeavour to make the school aware of any concerns or problems that might affect my child's work or behaviour.
- Ensure that my behaviour is respectful and appropriate.
- Ensure that social media is not used to express grievances about the school, the staff or the pupils. I will raise any grievance with the appropriate member of staff in the order: Class Teacher, Senior Leader, Headteacher, Chair of Governors.
- Support the school's policies, the Parent's Acceptable Use Agreement and the school's guidelines for behaviour and attendance.
- Encourage and support my child's home learning by helping them to complete homework and read, ideally daily.
- Attend Learning Conferences to discuss my child's progress and make an appointment to see my child's teacher to discuss any other issues that concern me.

- Learn and understand our Mission Statement and try to live it.
- Work hard in class and at home with my homework.
- Be polite, kind and helpful to everyone at school, at home and anyone else I meet.
- Wear my school uniform with pride and do my best to keep it safe and tidy.
- Tell my teacher if I am unwell, unhappy or worried.
- Ensure that my conduct online is kind and respectful to all.


By signing this agreement, we are agreeing to adhere to the Code of Conduct, the school expectations for conduct onsite and the Acceptable Use of ICT Policy.

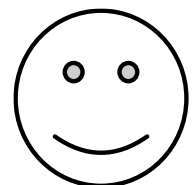
