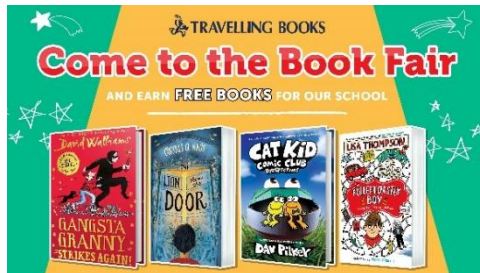

## CELEBRATE READING AT OUR BOOK FAIR



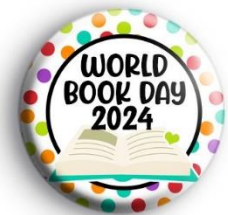
The Book Fair will be arriving in school next week with hundreds of new children's books to browse and buy. **Come and join us!**
