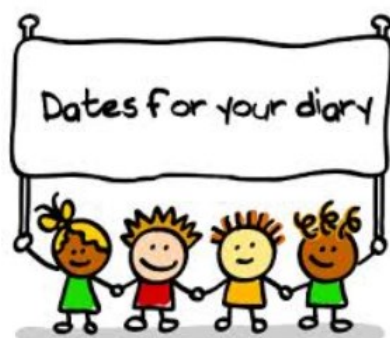

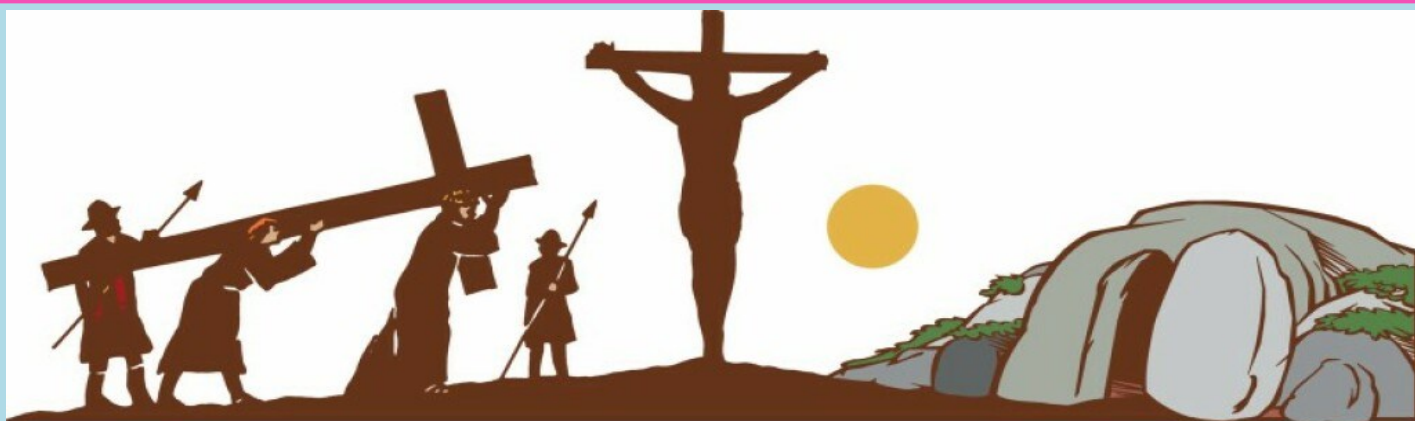


Chatterbox
