Whole school **93.26%**.

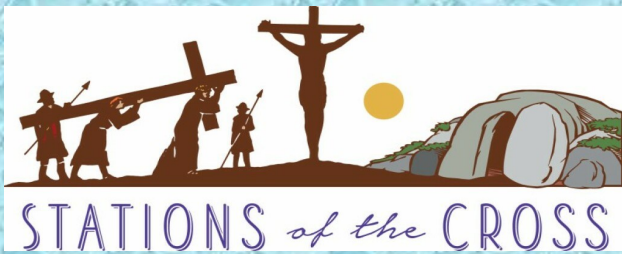

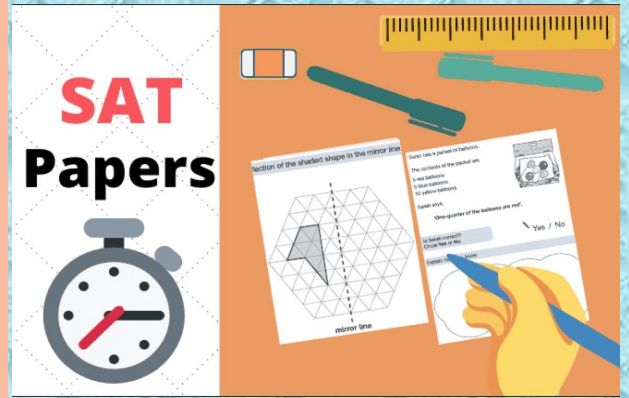
It is a legal requirement for your children to be in school every day.
